## State funding aiding firm's move to local headquarters

Consolidation of a company's Pennsylvania-based operations at a single headquarters facility in Monroeville is among projects that will benefit from \$35 million in economic development investments announced by Gov. Ed Rendell.

Cardinal Resources LLC, an employee-owned global provider of environmental assessment, remediation and engineering services, is ex-panding because it has three new alternative approaches for water treatment problems.

The company now leases 3,000 square feet of space at two locations.

Cardinal Resources is seeking approximately 7,000 square feet to consolidate its office and lab space.

The \$856,200 project is expected to create at least 25 new jobs within three years and retain 12 existing jobs.

The state Department of Community and Economic Development is providing the company with a package worth \$67,500 -- a \$25,000 Opportunity Grant, \$17,500 in job training funds and \$25,000 in job creation tax credits.
